As part of the current requirements by the waterboard, all members should complete a **Sediment and Erosion Control Plan (SECP)** for their property (or leased property). Included in this mailer.

**Please complete this BY DECEMBER 31st to be in compliance with this program- it is mandatory.**

**Once you complete the SECP for your property, keep on site for your records.**

(you do NOT need to mail PNSSNS a copy)

There are 3 ways you can complete the education and get help completing your Sediment and Erosion Control plan:

1. An online, short educational SECP course found online at:

You can complete the online course, short, open book 30 question test and print out the certificate for your records. (we get reports so we know who has completed this) AND then complete your Sediment and Erosion Control Plan for your property and keep for your records.

2. Attend the upcoming Sediment and Erosion Control workshop especially for those without computers or would like to attend the workshop in person. See the enclosed workshop flyer for Tuesday, November 6th 10am-1pm. Must RSVP and is limited to 50 people. Please reserve your spot right away. Please show up as you are taking the spot of someone who would like to take this workshop. The flyer has RSVP details. The workshop has certified trainers by the waterboard, easy to understand course, short, open book test after and you will receive a certificate when you pass the test for self-certification. The course provides information to help you complete your Sediment and Erosion Control Plan for your property.

3. The 3rd option allows you to have a certified person/ business (typically an engineer) to certify your SECP and they can provide a plan for your property but this is at your cost. You do not have to attend the training or take the test for self-certification as this option allows a professional to certify your plan.
