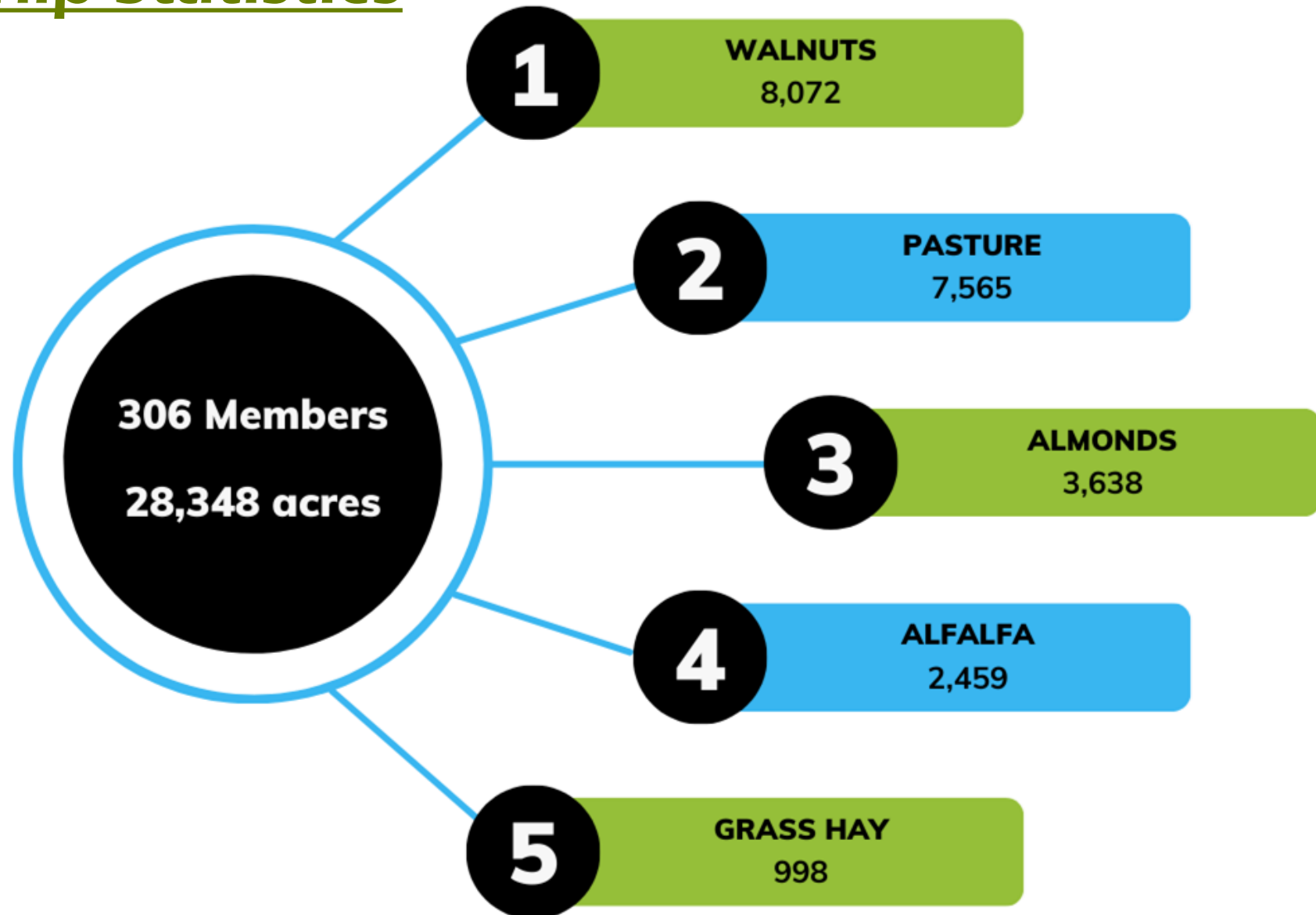

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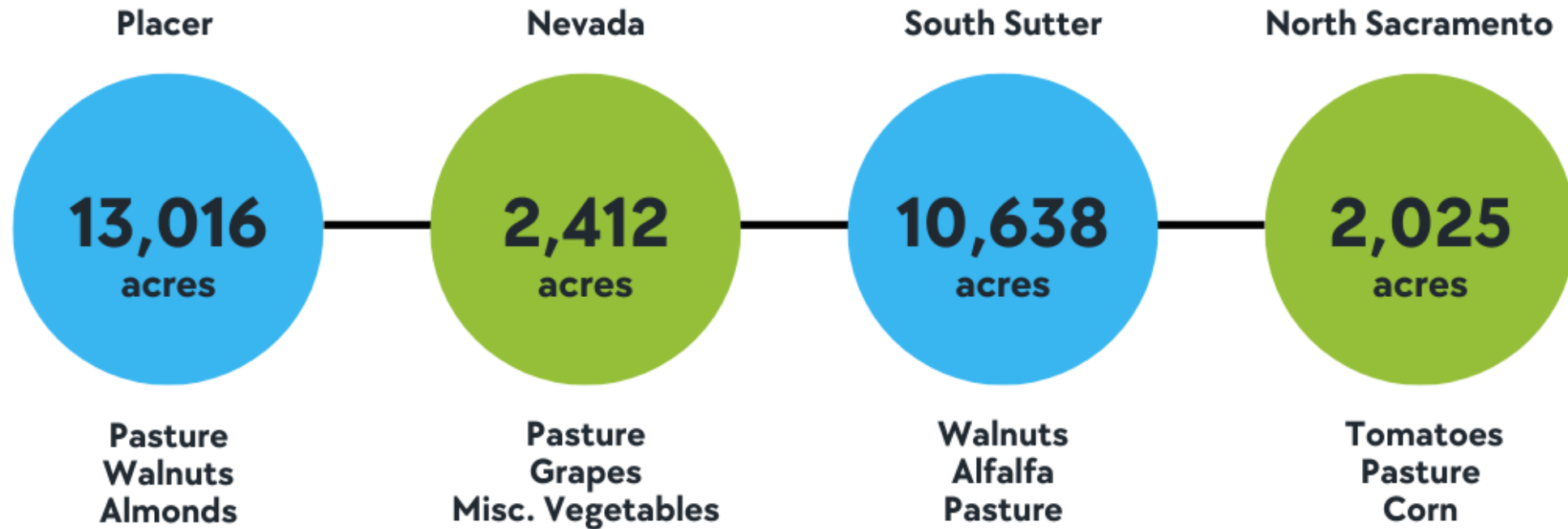

- Notify well users of potential human health impacts of nitrates in drinking water.

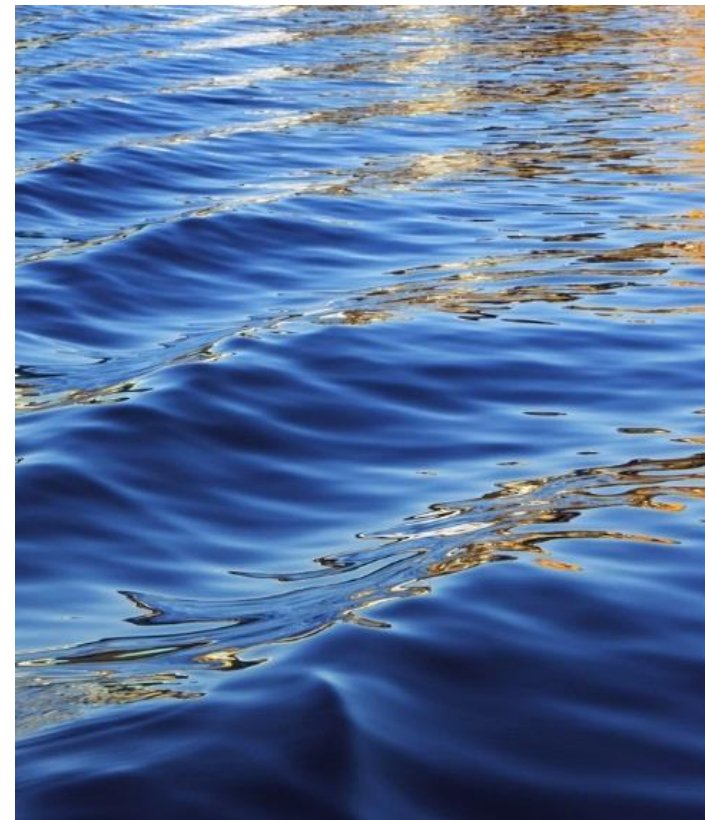
Who is required to sample?

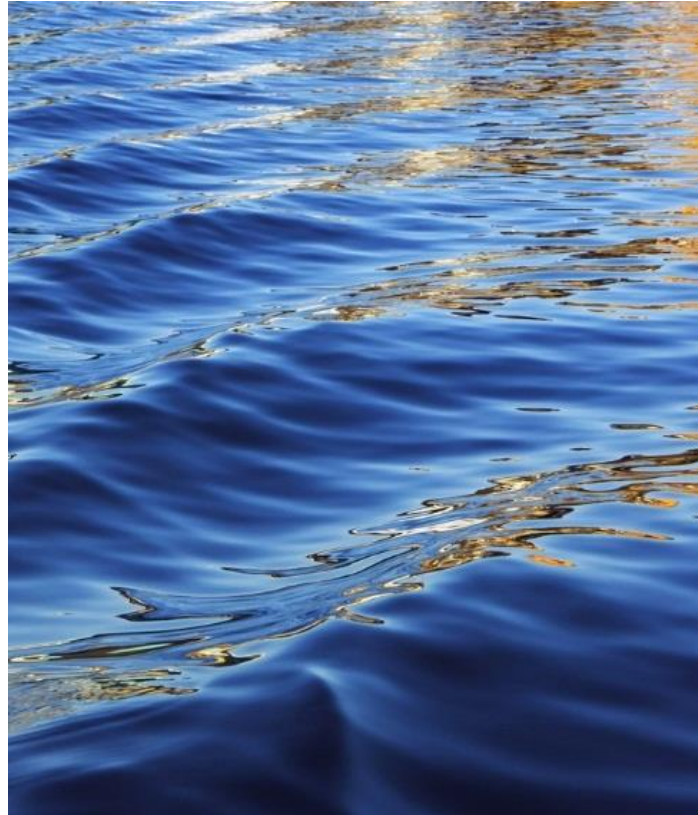
