- Applies to all drinking water wells that on enrolled Parcels.

- Notify well users of potential human health impacts of nitrates in drinking water.

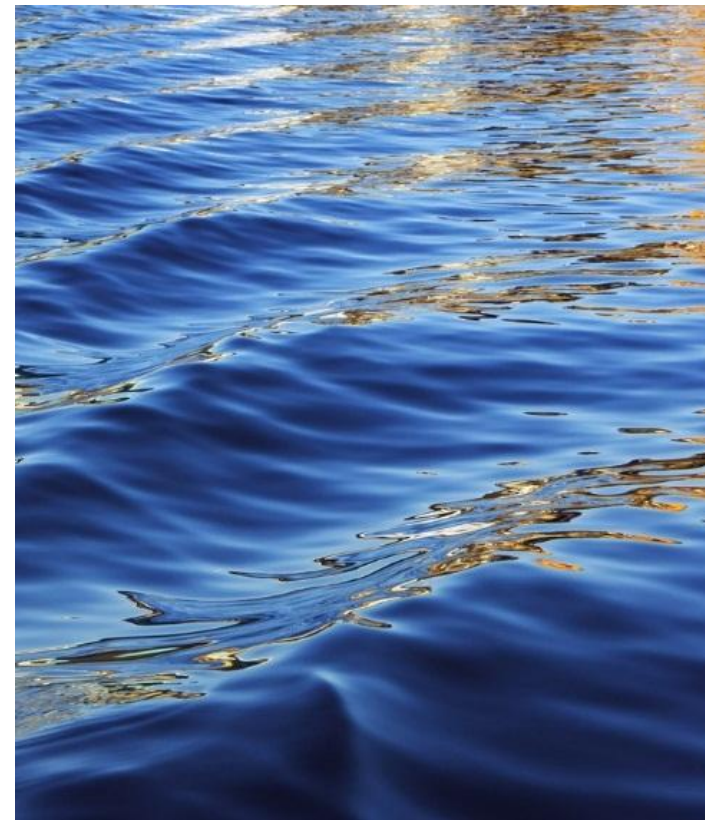
Who is required to sample?

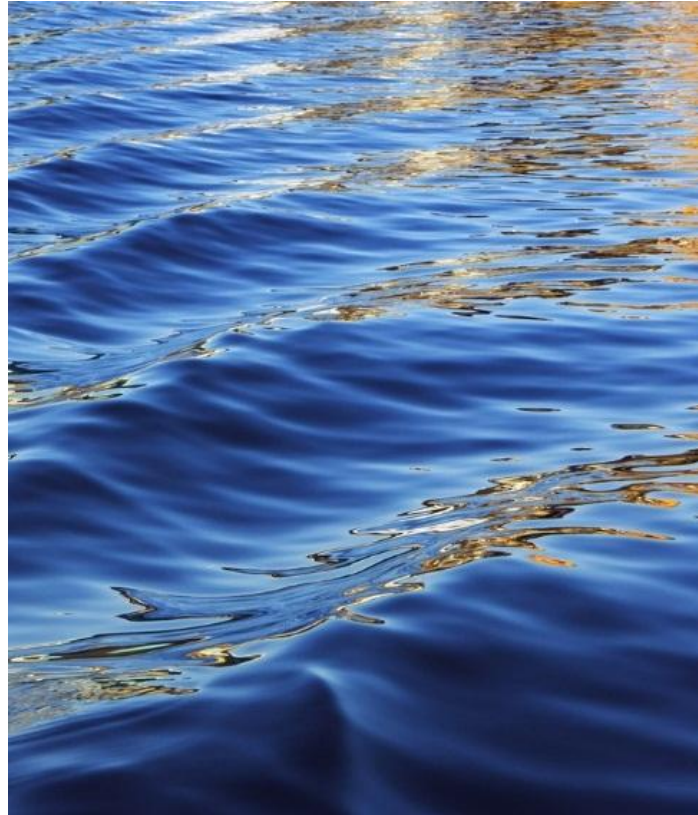
